

Magento 2 Brand Slider Extension

Created: 07/20/2020
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Installation

Never do anything directly on a live store. First setup and test on a development domain (i.e. "dev.url.com").

Make sure that you [set](#) your Magento application to the developer [mode](#).

Temporarily disable Magento cache

To avoid any possible issues with the installation we recommend disabling Magento cache before proceeding with the installation and re-enabling it once the install is complete.

1. Log in to your Magento admin
2. Go to System > Cache Management
3. Select "Select All" in the "Mass Actions" drop down
4. Select "Disable" in the "Actions" drop down and Click Submit
5. Once the page reloads **log out of the admin**

Upload Extension

Unzip the extension zip file and upload all files and folders of Backend and BrandSlider extension to the root folder of your Magento installation.

Install Extension

Enable Acx_Backend, Acx_BrandSlider module.

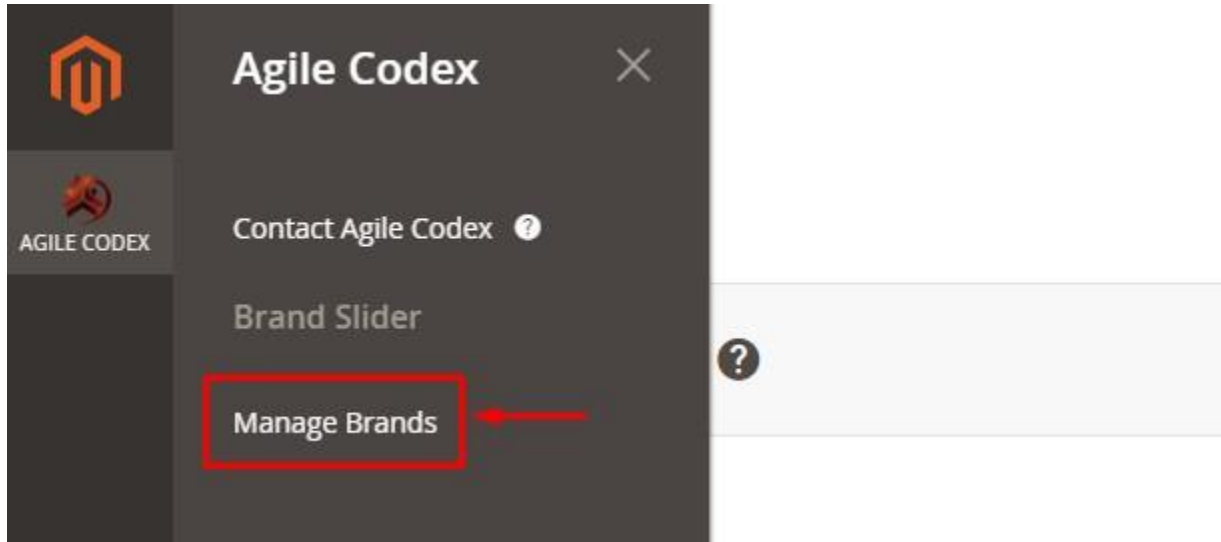
1. Upgrade and deploy.

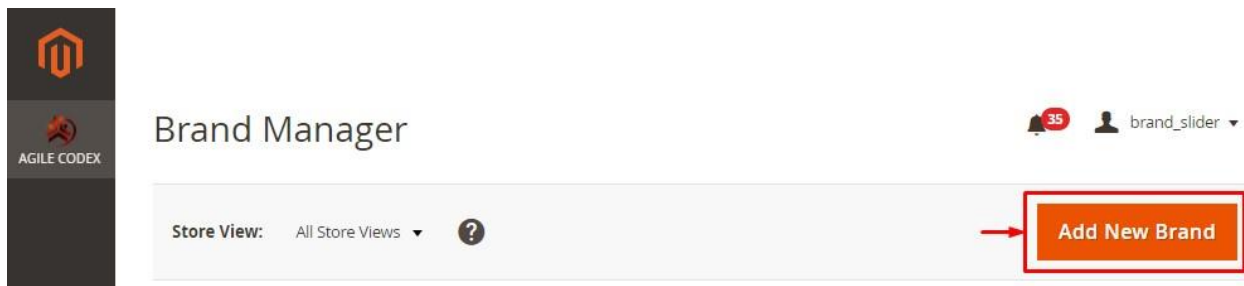
Manage Brand Slider







1. Go to **CONTENT** -> **Pages** -> CMS page
